The Vineyard

Old-vines of Meunier planted on a gentle north-eastern slope in Troissy. Leached clay soil (very little sandstone remaining). Very small yields.



Still wines are a real challenge for our estate. Every aspect of our work has to be rethought: from the choice of the plot, the date of the harvest, to the wine-making and ageing methods...

The meunier grape is fully at home in this region of champagne – a true expression of "terroir". It is all the more unusual to find meunier used to produce a red wine (pinot noir being more commonly used).

The Wine

The grapes were hand-picked at the end of the harvest. Vinified by full grapes maceration, fermented and aged in small oak barrels for 24 months. No filtration or fining.

Bottling date: 08 October 2020 (567 bottles 75cl)

The Service

Serve in a red wine glass above 12°C.
