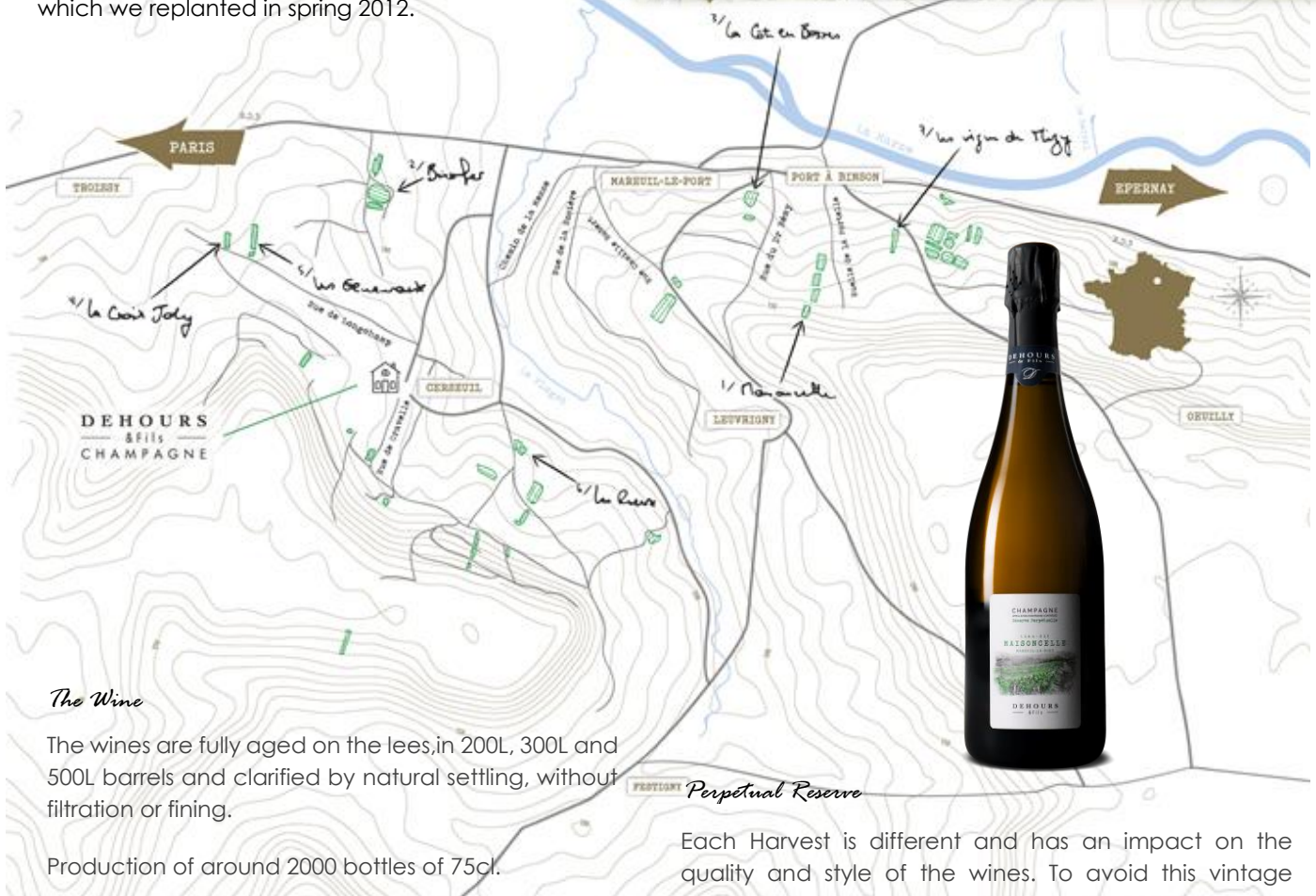
MAREUIL-LE-PORT

The Vineyard

Maisoncelle comes from one of our rare plots of old (and so small-yield) pinot noir vines.

It is situated halfway up the slope, above the Village of Port à Binson (within the Mareuil le Port district) and has a North-East orientation. The plot is over 300m long, with clay/silt soil, poor in limestone and rich in iron. Most of the vines are pinot noir with just a little meunier stock.

For this wine, to ensure the best results, we only use grapes from the vines at the bottom of the plot which we replanted in spring 2012.



The Wine

The wines are fully aged on the lees, in 200L, 300L and 500L barrels and clarified by natural settling, without filtration or fining.

Production of around 2000 bottles of 75cl.

Dosage : 0g to 2g/l.

The Service

Serve in a big white wine glass at 10°C minimum.
Decanting is possible.

Each Harvest is different and has an impact on the quality and style of the wines. To avoid this vintage effect, we have developed a Perpetual Reserve for each of our single vineyard wine, since 2013.

Each plot's Reserve has gained balance over the time, with a distinctive renewal proportion. It may vary from 50 to 30% depending on the parcel.
